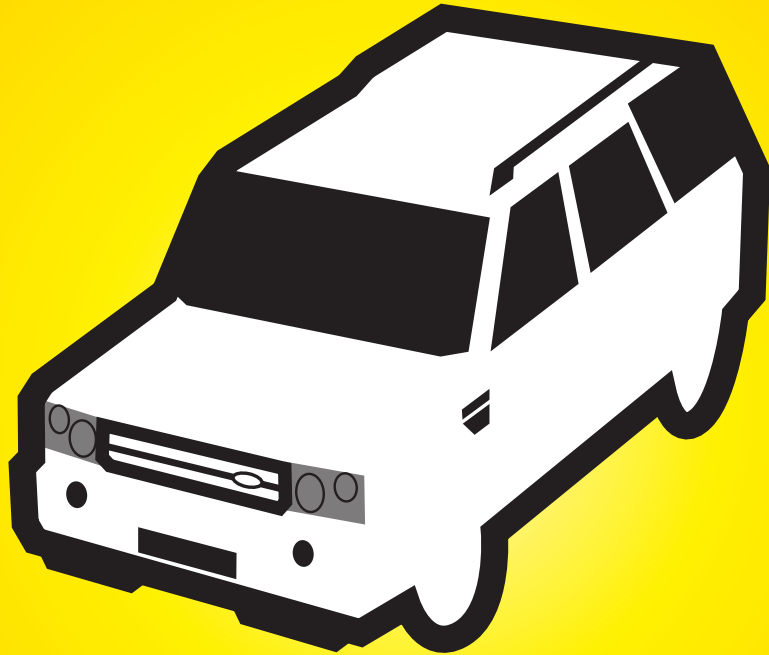

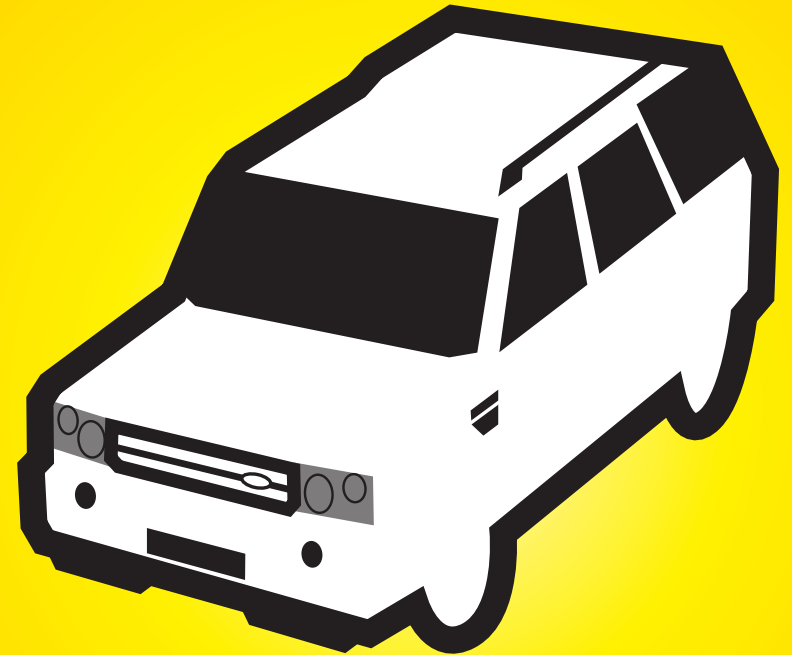

- Sat navs, mobile phones, money and CD players all make your vehicle attractive to thieves. Remove all valuables from your vehicle when you leave it and remember to rub off any marks left on your window by your Sat nav holder.
- Vehicles used for business purposes might also be a target. Take out tools, machinery or any other important equipment when you park up your vehicle. Their loss could have a devastating effect on your business and livelihood.
- Registration plates are attractive to thieves. Think about having tamper-proof plates and/or screws fitted.
- When parking in a public place try to look for a car park that has 'Park Mark' accreditation or is well lit and covered by CCTV.
- At home don't keep your vehicle keys next to the door - thieves sometimes break in to homes purely to steal the keys to vehicles.
- If you have a garage, use it to keep your vehicle secure and out of sight from burglars. If you must park your vehicle on your drive or on the street, park in a well lit area and if you have gates on your driveway, make sure they are locked at all times.
- If your vehicle doesn't have an alarm or immobiliser, get one fitted! There are many reasonably priced after market options available.
