166/19 Highways - Craven Area Schemes

The following Traffic Regulation Orders for Addingham, as agreed by the Keighley Area Committee on 18 July, were considered:

Main St to Cross End Fold Removal of double yellow lines
Main St Extension of double yellow lines

The schemes were discussed, relevant plans having been reviewed outside the meeting, with a view to responding to BMDC's invitation to comment.

Resolved: That a response be sent to the highways authority setting out concerns, and, if necessary, an objection, to the proposed imposition of additional No Wait Restrictions on Main St (scheme plan ref: 3.Main St Con-1A), on the grounds that the scheme would significantly reduce capacity for resident parking.

It was agreed that highways engineers should be invited to a meeting on site with representatives of the Parish Council to review the scheme.

167/19 Painted Ducks on Main St

Following recent resurfacing works on Main St, it was reported that BMDC had offered to reinstate the painted ducks at the corner by the Crown, and had suggested that a contribution to the quoted costs could be offered from the local community. It was noted that further advice was expected as regards the durability of the decoration and the level of contribution required. In light of this, the item was deferred for further consideration at the next meeting.
